

Lasso Tool cheatsheet for Photoshop



Lasso Tool draws a freeform selection.

To convert the Lasso Tool to the Polygonal Lasso Tool while drawing, hold OPTION and the tool will convert while option is held down.

Magnetic Lasso Tool draws a selection based on the edge tolerance and contrast (set in the Photoshop Control Bar) of what is being selected.





Polygonal Lasso Tool draws a selection consisting of line segments.

To convert the **Polygonal Lasso Tool** to the **Lasso Tool** while drawing, hold **OPTION** and the tool will convert while option is held down.

When using the **Polygonal Lasso Tool** and drawing tine segments, you can use the **DELETE** key to **delete a**line **segment** while drawing, before you close the selection.







To **ADD** to an existing selection using *any* Lasso Tool, hold **SHIFT** and the Lasso tool will get a (+) next to it, then draw an additional selection.



To **SUBTRACT** a part of an existing selection using *any* Lasso Tool, hold **OPTION** and the Lasso tool will get a minus (–) next to it, then draw over the part of the selection to delete.



In the Photoshop Control Bar, you can do the same add/ subtract options by choosing one of the 4 selection icons.





1. New selection
2. Add to selection

3. Subtract from selection 4. Intersect with selection
